## Eighty-Second Annual Report and Balance Sheet

To be presented to Members at the Annual General Meeting to be held at History House, 8 Young Street, Circular Quay, on Wednesday, 18th August, 1954.

---

The Committee has pleasure in presenting its Report and Balance Sheet for the year ended 31st July, 1954.

### RACING.

The 1953/54 Season's Programme commenced with Invitation Races at the Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron Opening Day Regatta, on 12th September, 1953, when the Club was invited to compete in races in three Divisions.

The Club's racing fleet was also invited to race during the season by the Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron, Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club, Royal Prince Edward Yacht Club, Royal Naval Sailing Association, Lake Macquarie Yacht Club, Middle Harbour Yacht Club, and the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia. The Club's fleet also took part in races at the Anniversary and Pittwater Regattas. The Committee desires to express its appreciation of the courtesies extended to our members by the Clubs and Regattas abovementioned.

Flag Day was held on the first Saturday in November, when a big programme covering the five divisions and Jubilee Class Yachts of the Royal Clubs, the Royal Naval Sailing Association and the North Shore 12ft. Sailing Club, in addition to our own three Divisions, was conducted in the usual satisfactory manner. The Committee's thanks are due to Messrs. F. F. Buchanan and N. M. Goddard, who together with the Honorary Assistant Secretary, carried out this onerous task.

The Club's Race Officials for the season were Messrs. Walter and Laurence Rayment, who carried out this task with the assistance of Mr. Bob Drummond, from Mr. Drummond's motor yacht. The thanks of the Club Members generally and the racing boat owners in particular are due to these gentlemen, who devoted a considerable amount of time to the Club and carried out their duties in an able manner.

Details of the Race results for the season are given later in this report, and the Committee desires to congratulate Dr. W. Wearn and Messrs. D. J. Hunter and J. Stuart-Duff for winning the Club's Gold Medals in their respective Divisions by very consistent sailing throughout the season.

### SOCIAL.

Club social functions on the Harbour during the season comprised Flag Day on 7th November, 1953, and Closing Day on 10th April, 1954, when the Motor Vessel "La Radar" was chartered for the convenience of Members and their friends. Good weather was experienced on both occasions and the functions proved most enjoyable. In addition a Rendezvous week-end was

held on 14th November, 1953, and this proved to be very popular with the skippers and crews of the many Yachts that attended.

Ladies' Nights were conducted in conjunction with the December and April General Meetings, and were most successful. At the Christmas meeting Dr. F. A. Bellingham screened his films of the previous Sydney-Hobart Ocean Race and the Great Barrier Reef, and also a film made under the direction of Ratsey and Laphorn Ltd., on the Making and Care of Yacht Sails. At the April Meeting Mr. Nigel B. Love screened films taken by him during the Royal Visit to Sydney and of a trip to England during 1950. All the films shown were of a very high standard and members are very much indebted to Dr. Bellingham and Mr. Love for the courtesies extended to members at these meetings.

The Club is also indebted to Messrs. Rolf Marks and Harry Begg for films screened at the October meeting, and to the N.S.W. Film Council for films made available to the Club at the March meeting. Mr. Water Rayment's chat on his earlier recollections of the Club at the September meeting was also most interesting and informative.

The Committee endeavours to have some suitable entertainment to follow each Club meeting, where official business is not heavy, and it is noted that the attendance of members at such meetings is an indication of their interest. During the past year the average attendance was 66.

The Club Ball and Presentation of Prizes was held at the "New Commodore," 97 Goulburn Street, Sydney, on Friday evening, 18th June, 1954. There was a good attendance of members and their friends, and the Committee desires to place on record its appreciation of the work of the Rear-Commodore, Mr. Tony Furse, and Mrs. Furse, who devoted a great deal of time to the organisation of the Ball.

#### FINANCIAL.

The Honorary Treasurer's audited Statements of Receipts and Expenditure and the Balance Sheet for the season just completed are printed elsewhere in the report. It will be noted that the previous year's small surplus has not been repeated. This is due to the continued rise in the cost of administration, although social functions, particularly the Ball, were successful financially and economies were effected where possible, such as the reduction of the size of the racing programme.

The Committee desires to record its appreciation of the generous assistance of those members who made donations to the prize fund or presented special trophies for competition during the past season. A list of the members concerned and their donations appears elsewhere in the report.

## OBITUARY.

The Committee records with regret the untimely death of Mr. C. P. Royle during the past season. Paul Royle, who was an active sailing man in the crew of his father's yacht, "Womerah," and also a crew member in ocean yacht races, joined the Club in 1945.

## GENERAL.

At the Eighty-First Annual General Meeting, the Members, on the nomination of the Committee, unanimously elected Mr. H. S. Lloyd an Honorary Life Member for services rendered to the Club. Mr. Lloyd, who joined in 1933, became Rear-Commodore in 1936, Vice-Commodore in 1937, and Commodore in 1938, a position which he held during the war years and until 1948. He has always been an untiring worker in the interests of the Sydney Amateurs.

Mr. H. E. Pfeiffer, who was Rear-Commodore in 1949, and Vice-Commodore from 1950, after serving some years as a Committee Member, is not seeking re-election as a Flag Officer.

Mr. W. S. Chambers, who has been Honorary Assistant Secretary since 1950, is not seeking re-election owing to pressure of business. Messrs. W. Rayment and C. W. Robson, the two oldest members of the present Committee and Honorary Life Members of the Club for past services are also not seeking re-election.

The Committee desires to place on record its appreciation of the services rendered to the Club by Messrs. H. E. Pfeiffer, W. S. Chambers, C. W. Robson, and W. Rayment, and to express its regret that they are unable to continue in the various offices held during the last season.
