To conduct over 120 races during a season extending from early September until the following April, to attend to the starting, handicapping and programming, to schedule and hear protests, to collect fees and distribute prizes, and finally to present an Annual Report entails many hours of hard work, and I am sure all members will join with me in congratulating all those concerned on the excellent manner in which they have carried out their duties.

I am most disappointed that negotiations for Club facilities have so far proven futile, in spite of many hours of endeavour spent by your Committee. The ever increasing cost of yachting must, I feel, eventually lead to some form of co-operative effort by the S.A.S.C. to provide facilities for members at reasonable cost.

Although I will not be your Commodore in the 1960/61 Season I will as always render any possible assistance, and I suggest that the Club-house project be pursued.

I would further suggest that every consideration be given to the introduction of a training scheme for younger enthusiasts or that a new class of yacht for younger lads be sponsored by the Club as a means of gaining new members and stimulating the lagging interest of older ones.

I wish to thank all who have shown their loyalty during my term of office and to take this opportunity to state that it has been an honour to be your Commodore.

ADMINISTRATION

Four meetings of this Sub-Committee were held during the year and, due mainly to the untiring efforts of the Hon. Secretary, Mr. Middleton, a full agenda was completed.

Rules: The old Club rules, which for many years had been amended and altered to comply with changing conditions were completely redrafted. These rules were submitted to members and approved at a general meeting on 13th April, 1960. The Committee decided that new Rule Books should not be printed for a period of six months in order to provide full opportunity for members who so desired to propose any amendments to the rules before the Club was committed to the expense of printing. Two major alterations of note were (a) the restriction on the re-election of Flag Officers after three consecutive years in office. (b) The election of members to be carried out by Committee instead of by members at a General Meeting.

Club House Project: Protracted negotiations were conducted with the North Sydney Council with regard to Council permission to develop a section of Council Water Frontage Reserve at High Street, North

Sydney, as a club house and mooring site. However, after a very favourable early reception the Council finally decided against our proposal. A proposition to purchase a boatshed and 55 mooring sites in Mosman Bay was fully investigated, but, unfortunately, before final negotiations could be completed, the vendor accepted another bidder. In all, it was a very disappointing year in this regard.

RACING

The 1959-60 season provided good racing for the Club's fleet, some 45 yachts being entered in the four divisions.

The Point Score Competitions were, as usual, keenly contested throughout the season. The trophies donated by Messrs. Merrington, Cameron, Carment and Begg, for Point Score leaders at Christmas, helping to sustain the interest in the earlier races.

Our Flag Day Regatta was most successful. A very large fleet of yachts, representing every Sydney Yacht Club racing with us, provided a fine spectacle.

The Bluebird Division continued to maintain its strength and provide keen class racing at a reasonable cost. The Club was extremely happy to assist in the staging of the Bluebird Championship on the 20th and 21st February, 1960. These comprised four (4) races and attracted some thirty (30) entries, more than half being members of the S.A.S.C.

This season was the first year in which the New Racing Regulations applied and lectures kindly delivered by Mr. R. Morgan, of R.P.E.Y.C., greatly assisted members in their understanding of these regulations.

The Sailing Sub-Committee heard a number of protests during the year in connection with both the Bluebird Championship and our own Club racing.

Mr. Jack Millard, the Club Starter, once again earned the gratitude of all members by his invariably efficient handling of the Club's races and the Committee wishes to record its appreciation.

The Club Rendezvous was held at Quarantine Beach on 27th February, 1960. This was marred by bad weather, but attended by 55 members, and proved a most convivial get-together.

The 9th April, '60, dawned bright and clear, thus Closing Day was held under idyllic conditions, with perfect sailing weather. The Flagship "La Radar" was again the centre for the traditional dinghy races. Adequate refreshments made the afternoon most pleasant and satisfactory to all present. Due to the substantial donations, this function was also a financial success. In addition, we were hosts to the R.N.S.A. and enjoyed their company after their races. We also provided starting and finishing facilities for a private challenge race between "Defiance", "Waree", and "Varg", skippered by "Boy" Messenger, Bill Psaltis and John Wilson, respectively.

At the barbecue at Bonnie Doone, following the Bob Brown race at Easter, we were joined by the skippers and crews of the J.O.G., who had raced to Broken Bay with us for a trophy provided by the club. The evening was well patronised by both our members and the J.O.G., and should further cement the good relations between the two clubs.

During August, 1959, the Club held the 1958-59 Annual Ball and Presentation of Prizes at the Wentworth Hotel, and the Committee expresses its appreciation to Bill and Mrs. MacRae, and to Bruce and Mrs. Cameron, for their sterling efforts on the club's behalf, ensuring the success of this happy occasion. The usual monthly meetings were well attended and during the year we were fortunate to have the ladies join us at two General Meetings.

In conclusion, my appreciation to all those Club Officers and members for their wholehearted support of the Club's activities, which has done so much to assist in the smooth running of our Social programme.
