In 1872 a number of boat owners who regularly raced in Rose Bay held a meeting in Tom Kearney's Hotel at the top of William Street, Sydney and formed the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club. Originally the Club fostered a class of centreboard boats called "fishing boats" and at the commencement of the 1873-74 season there was a fleet of twenty. During the early years of the Club's existence almost all the open boat sailing races in Sydney were conducted by the Club.

Records from 1874 to 1876 mention several match races to Broken Bay and to Newcastle and return for stakes of £50 and £100 aside. In 1879 a waterfront block of land was granted to the Club at Bennelong Point (the Opera House now stands on the site), a Clubhouse was erected here and officially opened on the 21st April, 1883. This was the first Clubhouse erected by any Sailing Club in Australia; costing over £1,000 it measured 60'×45' and was looked upon as being the most commodious Clubhouse in the Colony. Unfortunately the land was resumed by the Government in October of the same year and after allowing for compensation the Club was left with a deficiency of £200.

Seven Committees were formed and reports upon their activities are presented herewith.

FINANCE—ADMINISTRATION

A. W. Merrington (Chairman); N. G. Cassim, J. A. Middleton, J. Tomasetti, B. Woods.

This Committee has continued to advise the Board of Directors on matters of Finance and Administration of Club affairs. It has prepared Budgets for the guidance of Officers in Charge of the various departments of the Club.

Considerable time was spent considering amendments to the Memorandum and Articles of the Club. These are incomplete but should be finalised at an early date.

A poll of yacht owners registered with the Club was conducted to determine the possible usage of improved slipping and other facilities. The results were favourable and recommendations to the Board have opened the way for these improvements.

Members will note that the format of the statement of Receipts and Expenditure has been changed in order to record more clearly the financial affairs of the Club's various departments.

RACING

The growth of our racing fleet in the past season justified forming four divisions which provided closer and keener racing. The success of handicapping was clearly demonstrated in the third division, where with one point score race left, six yachts could have won the gold medal. The results in other divisions were similar, although not quite as open.

The Bluebird Division has recovered in strength with sixteen entries. The new starting line for north easterly winds proved very successful, and the introduction of numeral boards simplified starting procedure.

The Club was represented internationally in Seattle, U.S.A. in Thunderbird Class Championships by Dick Christian ("Christina") and issued a challenge on behalf of Bruce Cameron ("Wathara 11") for the One Ton Cup to be sailed in French waters. A junior member Mr. A. R. Tyson also represented the Club at the Flying Fifteen Championship in Western Australia.

Our starting officials, Messrs. Millard and Cambridge once again did a splendid job for a fleet of nearly one hundred yachts.

BOATSHED

The boatshed amenities area was completed. There is now hot water to the shower and handbasin, the floor was tiled and the walls painted. These facilities are now being enjoyed by many sailing members.

An additional fifteen dinghy racks were erected, giving a total of 57. Additional moorings were laid and are now 45. All moorings were lifted and serviced during June, 1967, and are now in first-class condition. Each marker buoy has been numbered to correspond with a master chart in the boatshed showing names and addresses of owners.

The slipway was very well patronised, sometimes proving insufficient to meet the demand by members.

Construction of a new slipway has been approved by the Directors, and plans have been submitted to the Maritime Services Board. A boathand will be employed to service yachts, and it is proposed to purchase a suitable craft for use as a tender and workboat.

A new winch was donated by Frank Bradshaw, and is in the boatshed awaiting installation on the new slipway.

CLUBHOUSE—SOCIAL

Fifteen social functions were held during the 1966-67 season. These included Ladies' Nights, the Annual Ball, a theatre party, a beer tasting and other evening and day functions. Attendances at the functions were encouraging and reflect a continuance of the happy relations and atmosphere among members.

Highlights of the year were the Annual Ball (attendance 230) the Commodore's Flag Night and the Northcott Crippled Children's Day. The Ladies' Auxiliary did a sterling job both in raising money beforehand and in catering on the day itself. John Hemphill kindly made available a pontoon for which Sam Freeman donated hessian to cover the flooring. In all 107 children and 55 attendants and drivers were entertained, this being made possible by the generosity of owners who made their boats available for the occasion.

The success of the year's activities could not have been realised without the willing assistance of the Social Secretary, Geoff Cambridge and the members of the Committee.

Proof of success are an ever-increasing band of willing workers on the Committee and a small fund to be spent on necessities in the Club.
