

Eight Committees were formed and reports upon their activities are presented herewith.

FINANCE—ADMINISTRATION

The Finance-Administration Committee met seven times during the past year and thirty-six separate recommendations were made to the Directors on matters concerning Club management. Careful surveillance of Club finances has been maintained, particularly in our new trading ventures. Suitable systems have been installed to control our expanding activities.

This Committee recommends that a period of consolidation be embarked upon in the coming year. During this period the recent capital additions to the Club should be developed to the required level of economic self sufficiency in line with Club financial policy.

RACING

The growth of our racing fleet continued through the season. The Club provided weekly racing for four handicap divisions, Thunderbird Class, Bluebird Class and Flying Fifteen Class. While we had 111 entries on our programme an average of eighty yachts crossed the starting line each week. Racing was keen and close, handicapping as successful and fair as possible. In most divisions the Point Score winners were not decided until the last race. The quality of our racing did contribute to the success in inter-club events. The Club won the Daydream Shield for the first time and the Teams Race for the second time in succession.

Our thanks go again to our untiring starting officials headed by Jack Millard.

BOATSHED

Several working bees were organised for improvements in and around the Boatshed, also to build the second slipway cradle and to concrete around the slipway down to low water.

Thanks are due to the above committee, also the Commodore, John Jackson, R. L. Skinner, G. Brackenbury, M. J. S. Ormsby, and G. Cranna for their generous assistance, and to K. Spence for wiring up the second slipway motor. A special mention for Jan Aldous for the wonderful work he has done, especially designing and building the second slipway winch drive mechanism. This slipway was put into service during April 1968, and is proving a great success. The old slipway has been used a great deal during the last twelve months, and has been a good source of income.

The club purchased 12 extra moorings in Mosman Bay, which gives a total of 58 moorings in excellent condition as they are serviced once a year.

Tony Ashleigh was employed last August as boathand and has been kept busy servicing members' yachts, both on and off the slips.

A tender was launched last October and has provided a tender service each race day since then; it is also used as a work boat for the club.

During 1968/69 season it is proposed to build a fitting-out wharf with light, power, water and mast-lifting gear.

CLUBHOUSE—SOCIAL

With the completion of the new entrance foyer, office, store, kitchen renovation and brick path to the front door, the clubhouse is now much more attractive inside, functions better, and lends itself more readily to use for social functions.

It was completed just prior to the Commodore's Flag Night and Flag Day which were both well attended and important pre-season functions. The new surroundings have met with Members' unanimous approval and drawn complimentary remarks from visiting yachtsmen and Flag Officers from other Clubs.

The Annual Ball in June 1967 attracted 250 members and friends to an enjoyable and very successful occasion at the Wentworth Hotel. The remainder of the season was highlighted by the Christmas dance-party and the Northcott Crippled Children's Day. More than 100 children were sailed or motored around the harbour and entertained at the Clubhouse with food, fishing and speed-boat rides. It was a happy day, which once again, as a direct result of much generous voluntary work, was highly successful.

During the year films were shown on the One Ton Cup Challenge and the 1967-68 Hobart Race as filmed by Total Oil. We were also treated to a preview of an excellent film — "18 Footers" — directed and produced for the Department of the Interior by Jack Rogers.

Other social events held at the Clubhouse included closing day, prize-giving and several Ladies-night cocktail parties.

Acting as Clubhouse and Social Secretary Geoff Cambridge has done a splendid job during the year.

DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The committee met regularly during the year. A sketch plan of improved ladies toilet facilities was prepared and was accepted by the Directors. A plan for a fitting out berth has been prepared for consideration of the Directors.

The committee is negotiating with the relevant Authorities, with a view to obtaining leases for Club purposes of land between the clubhouse and the water front.

HISTORICAL PUBLICATIONS

This Committee has undertaken two tasks:

- (a) The documentation of the Club's activities since its inauguration.
- (b) The preparation of a manuscript concerning highlights of the Club's Members and Boats, to be published for the Centenary in 1972.

Work is proceeding on both counts.

During the year the Ladies' Auxiliary has actively helped to promote family interests in the S.A.S.C. with afternoon tea being provided on opening and closing days and in December a Christmas Tree Party for Members' children. Other functions (to raise money for Crippled Children's Day), were a Wine Tasting and Theatre Party, arrangements for these being made at three meetings during the year.
