COMMODORE'S REPORT

Last year I reported that the policy of your Board had been one of consolidation. Efforts were directed in that period towards the creation of a foundation on which to build for the future. It is my pleasure to report that during the period under review your Board was able to build in a number of areas on that foundation.

Physical development brought to fruition a number of plans and at the same time incurred the Club in a record level of expenditure. This development included stage one of a building renovation and redevelopment programme. This first stage provided for the demolition of part of the rear section of the main Clubhouse building and the rebuilding of an enlarged structure together with the provision of new building services to cater for the Club's overall needs.

Other physical development included the replacement of the Club tender by a new vessel built and fitted to club specification and major rectification work on Club slipways.

A number of changes took place in your management team during the year and the new blood as may be expected proved a stimulus in debate around the Board table and at Committee level. It was the Board's pleasure to welcome Vic Dibben as Rear Commodore, Geoff Paton as Hon. Secretary, Peter Chapman as Race Secretary, and more recently Fred Bevis as Hon. Treasurer. Fred took over from Tony Newton who relinquished the position towards the end of the year. The Board on that occasion thanked Tony for a job well done over the past two seasons.

Regrettably the clubs human resources suffered a further set back at the end of the year. Mrs. Kartzoff, Assistant Secretary for over ten years, decided that it was time to retire from the waterfront and seek drier pastures. The best wishes and thanks of not only the Board but all members go with her for a job consistently and conscientiously performed over an important decade in the history of the Club.

Sailing as usual continued as the Club's primary objective and witnessed a further growth in activities. This resulted in the Chairman of the Race Committee, Peter Hamilton, relinquishing his combined role of Chairman/Secretary and as indicated above, a separate Race Secretary was appointed.

Boatshed activities were again controlled by Vice Commodore Bob Skinner. Under his chairmanship the committee this year coped more than ably with a growing volume of day to day activities. In addition it took over a section of the new building as a workshop and has further improvements in hand.

Clubhouse activities this year were ably steered by new Rear Commodore Vic Dibben. Vic has introduced a number of improvements for the benefit of members and record numbers at monthly general meetings testify to the quality of speakers and films he arranged throughout the year.

Finally a personal word of thanks to all who made progress possible during the year and who in so many ways contributed to the Amateurs.

To the Board, the Committees, the Starters, Mrs. Kartzoff, Tony Ashleigh and Carl Speers — thank you.

The year proved satisfactory in a number of respects. As mentioned above a record sum of money was spent on the Club development programme. Normal trading results in all departments were comparable with last year despite rising prices. Members will note that accounts also bear the unusually heavy repair component of the development programme which amounted to almost \$14,000.00. This was absorbed with a resultant nett loss for the year of less than \$9,000.00. With the assistance of the funds budgeting system introduced last year a finely tuned liquidity programme was regularly monitored and the Club finished the year in a satisfactory liquid state.

Forecasts for next year however reveal that we have not escaped the consequences of the inflationary economy in which we live. The Committee recently recommended to your Board that certain charges would have to be adjusted and this recommendation was unhappily but necessarily adopted by the Board.

BOATSHED

The year was one affected by the downturn in the economy and the trading position of the boatshed business has been under constant review. The operations have remained profitable due to the diligence of our staff and support from the members.

The remodelling of the premises caused dislocation but the new accommodation is of great assistance.

The committee has continued with the policy of upgrading and maintaining the facilities.

The new tender/workboat, appropriately named the 'Nancy K' has been, like the lady herself, a great success. The boat was launched with due ceremony by Nan Kartzoff at a pleasant ceremony in October, 1976.

The Boatshed committee is indebted to Tony Ashleigh, Peter Wargent, and Carl Speers and would like to record its special thanks to Nancy Kartzoff who resigns from her Club employment at the end of June.

CLUBHOUSE

The objective of the Committee has been to improve the services for the members in the Clubhouse and to encourage more members to participate in clubhouse activities. There are three areas in which the committee has worked to achieve this—the clubhouse facilities, general meetings and social functions in the clubhouse.

A deep freeze storage unit and a new refrigerator have been purchased. In addition, the new amenities section for the ladies and upgrading of the men's wash room, which had been planned for some time, was approved by the Directors, a contract was let and the work completed. These facilities have greatly added to the facilities at the clubhouse for the benefit of members.

At the general meetings the number of members and their friends attending has increased to the point where we could almost say "Full House" at the meetings.

There have been speakers with interesting subjects such as John Murray who circumnavigated the world in a trimaran and films, such as "The Pamir" a world famous tall ship, and the 1976 Hobart yacht race. On a large screen in the clubhouse the films were most spectacular.

A very successful Christmas function was held at the clubhouse with the committee catering. A full house capacity number of members and their friends attended. A barbecue and entertainment night catered by the Committee at the Club was also a successful evening.

On the annual Northcott Day when the Club entertains children from the Northcott and Manly Waringah schools, the committee was assisted and gratefully acknowledge the support and help from members to make it so successful. The schools advised that the day was one of the best held.

After the racing events the committee has catered for those members and their crews returning to the Clubhouse, and at Store Beach at the conclusion of the Idle Hour trophy race, mention must be made here for the assistance given by Tony Ashleigh and his friends.

Also, SASC and Middle Harbour Club members and their crews were entertained at Taylors Bay after the Daydream Shield trophy race which was well attended and enjoyed by those participating.

The members of the Clubhouse Committee feel well rewarded for their efforts and appreciate and thank the Club members for the support which has been given them. The committee also records its thanks to Mrs. Kartzoff, Tony Ashleigh, Carl Speers and Peter Wargent.

DEVELOPMENT

Activity during the 1976-77 year has been restricted to completion of the Club's new chandlery section, workshop and toilet facilities.

This operation has consumed a large proportion of the Club's financial reserves. The work has been satisfactorily completed and is now in service.

The Committee also undertook upgrading of the No. 1 slipway, which has been stabilised and is also operating satisfactorily.

The Committee's forward planning activities have necessarily been inhibited by the building work and large expenditure, but it is hoped that this now being behind us, the incoming Committee will be able to devote more time to considering the Club's long-term development plans.

- The Daydream Shield was won by S.A.S.C.
- The second production yacht challenge, with 36 yachts from 12 classes sailing in 2 divisions, drew much favourable comment from participants, spectators and the yachting press.
- Championships for Thunderbird class yachts, and Port Jackson Regatta for Marauder class Yachts and Quarter-ton yachts were conducted on the Anzac weekend. New marks obtained in time for these events proved most successful.

SYDNEY AMATEUR SAILING CLUB DIRECTORS' REPORT

In accordance with a resolution of the board of directors, the directors report as follows with respect to the club's loss for the financial year ended 31st May, 1977 and the state of the club's affairs at that date.

1. The operating loss of the club for the year ended 31st May, 1977 was \$8,107.
The results of the club's operations during the financial year were in the opinion of the directors, substantially affected by considerable expense for substantial repairs and improvements to the leasehold and the resulting loss was not of a trading nature.
2. The directors recommend that no dividend be declared.
3. No issue of shares or debentures was made by the company during the financial year.
4. The directors took reasonable steps before the income and expenditure statements and balance sheet were made out to ascertain that all known bad debts were written off and that adequate provision was made for doubtful debts.
5. At the date of this report the directors are not aware of any circumstances which would render the amount written off for bad debts or the amount of the provision for doubtful debts inadequate to any substantial extent.
6. At the date of this report the directors are not aware of any circumstances which would render the values attributed to current assets in the accounts misleading.
7. No charge on the assets of the club has arisen since the end of the financial year to the date of this report to secure the liabilities of any other person.
8. No contingent liability has arisen since the end of the financial year to the date of this report.
9. No contingent or other liability has become enforceable or is likely to become enforceable within the period of twelve months after the end of the financial year which, in the opinion of the directors, will or may affect the ability of the company to meet its obligations when they fall due.
10. In the interval between the end of the financial year and the date of this report no item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature has arisen which is likely, in the opinion of the directors, to affect substantially the results of the club's operations for the next succeeding financial year.
11. Since the end of the previous financial year no director of the club has received or become entitled to receive a benefit (other than a benefit included in the aggregate amount of emoluments received or due and receivable by directors shown in the accounts, or the fixed salary of a full time employee of the club) by reason of a contract made by the club or a related corporation with the director or with a firm of which he is a member, or with a company in which he has a substantial financial interest.
