## COMMODORE'S REPORT

This year the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club has been in continuous operation for 108 years and Members must be proud of their Club and to know that it is still progressive.

If we had to make a short statement about the Club today we could say "The Sydney Amateur Sailing Club continues to thrive. In its ranks are all the best known sailing boats in the harbour; consequently the races are well contested".

That statement appeared 100 years ago in the Sydney "Bulletin" and while some ocean racing yachts may be better known, The Amateurs still has Members and yachts that have made their names known and are continuing to do so by participating in many yachting events.

Concerning our Club race programme, the Racing Committee including Director and Race Secretary, Rosemary Hay, the Committee Chairman, Charles Maclurcan, the Starter, Jack Millard and his team and Pat Ferris must be commended for a very successful year. Their efforts have resulted in a high standard of racing with considerable praise coming from our Members and Members of other Clubs.

The Cruising Division, under Chairman John Ward, with regular and increasing meetings continues to fulfill a special need for a section of Club Members.

The strength of the Amateurs is in its Members and their participation in the Club activities. Members of long standing, particularly Past Commodores, continue to take a keen interest in the Club and its affairs.

The Directors, which are elected by the Members and the various Committees, include Members with wide experience of Club activities and new Members with new ideas and this mixture has ensured The Amateurs remains one of the progressive Yacht Clubs in Australia.

The Directors and Committee Members are to be commended for their dedication and efforts to achieve their objectives.

During the past year the SASC Articles of Association, after protracted discussion between our Honorary Secretary, Arthur Prigge, the Club Solicitor, Past Commodore N.G. (Nick) Cassim and the Corporate Affairs Commission, have been updated and approved by Members.

An ongoing Clubhouse improvement and maintenance program has included the kitchen being rebuilt to a high standard and this work was completed during this year under the supervision of the Development Committee with Chairman, Dr Frank Buckley and the Club's Architect Graham McKinley.

As Commodore I am particularly grateful for the personal efforts by the Directors, Members of the Finance & Administration, Boatshed, Clubhouse, Development, Racing and Cruising Committees to ensure the Club has operated successfully and profitably. In particular the Honorary Secretary, Life Member, Arthur Prigge and Treasurer Fred Bevis, have devoted their skills and considerable personal time to ensure the Club complies with all legal requirements and the accounts are properly administrated.

In conclusion I would like to thank the Flag Officers, Directors, Committee Members and Members for their support and to our Assistant Secretary, Mrs Diana Fitzgerald, to Mrs Percival, Carl Speers and our Boatshed team, Tony Ashleigh and Peter Wargent, thank you for your contribution to the Amateurs.

The above represents a small reduction in membership for the year. The variation arises in part from a decline in new members and in part from resignations and members struck off.

As indicated in last year's report, a further phase of the redevelopment programme had been committed. The Starter's boat has been commissioned and a contract had been let for the reconstruction of the Club Kitchen. This latter project was successfully completed during the period.

In all the Club has invested about \$40,000 in this and a number of other redevelopment projects over the last two years. Funds for these projects was partly from reserves accumulated prior to the commencement of the programme and partly from bank borrowing. It is pleasing to note that as the year comes to a close the Club's indebtedness to the bank falls satisfactorily within the limits projected by our Finance Committee. It is anticipated that the loan will be substantially extinguished within the coming year.

Referring now to day to day operating costs, reference should be made to the accounts contained elsewhere in this report. Members will be pleased to note that costs have once again been contained to an acceptable level. It was with this knowledge that your Finance Committee recently was able to recommend to the Board a number of modest price increases for the coming year. Efforts meanwhile have been directed towards improving control systems so that your Board can continue to exercise tight control over the many facets of our operation.

## BOATSHED

Vice Commodore J.C. Jeremy (Chairman), R. Lawler, W.G. Brown, D. McCormack, O.M. Bradley, R. Chapman, P. McCallum.

During 1979/80, the main aim of the Boatshed committee has been to plan and begin implementing a programme of maintenance and gradual updating of the Boatshed facilities. The principal maintenance task required during the year was the replacement of one of the free standing piles off the club wharf which had broken close to the bottom. The opportunity was taken to replace one other deteriorated pile at the same time, the work being completed during March.

Demand for club mooring remains high, however, there appears little prospect of increasing the number available. MSB policy does however, now permit concentrated mooring fields in suitable locations which may offer some possibilities for the future.

During the year about 60% of available Boatshed time was sold, a similar proportion to last year. SASC rates compare very favourably with other yards in the Sydney area and the maximum use of the Boatshed facilities by members will ensure that they are **kept competitive.**

A considerable increase in Chandlery stock was achieved during the year particularly to improve the availability of commonly used fastenings. New racking has been purchased and procedures are being introduced to simplify and improve accounting.

"Captain Amora" has operated reliably during the year, and steady progress is being made with further improvements to her equipment to assist the starters. "Nancy K"

has shown some signs of a hard life, and some problems have been evident, particularly with the steering gear. A new system has been planned for installation during the winter of 1980.

Much work has been put into Boatshed activities by members of the committee, who have given generously of their own time to ensure that the costs of maintaining the Club's facilities are minimised. The Committee would also wish to record their appreciation for efforts of the 'sharp' end of the Boatshed, Tony Ashleigh and Peter Wargent, ably supported by Carl Speers.
