INVITATION

On Tuesday, 1st October 1872 in Tom Keary's Hotel on the corner of William and Brougham Streets Sydney, a meeting of 12 sailors culminated in the formation of the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club. In 2022 we celebrate our 150th Anniversary as one of the oldest sailing clubs in Australia.

A cordial invitation is extended to owners of all yachts to enter the SASC 150th Anniversary Regatta to be held on the waters of Sydney Harbour.

NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority is the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 including Australian Sailing Prescriptions.
- 1.2 The 2021-2024 Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) for Category 7 shall apply. Each yacht must hold a valid Equipment Audit form to a minimum standard Cat 7.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry is open to monohull yachts of traditional or modern design. Online entry is available on the SASC website: [TopYacht Online Entry](#)
- 2.2 Entries close on Monday 29th August 2022. Late entries or changes to entries may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The Entry Fee is \$45 SASC Members and \$50 Non-Members

4 ENTRY, DIVISIONS AND HANDICAPS

- 4.1 The OA at its discretion may choose to add or delete divisions depending on entry numbers. Divisions will include mixed divisions for spinnaker and non-spinnaker and classics divisions for spinnaker and non-spinnaker.
- 4.2 Divisions will be advised on the official list of entries available from the SASC website and will be emailed to all entrants.
- 4.3 PHS Handicaps will be based on a TCF (time correction factor)

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 The time of the first warning signal is 1325 hours.
- 5.2 Start sequence and code flags will be available in the Sailing Instructions.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available by 1700hrs on Friday 2nd September 2022 on the SASC website and will be emailed to all entrants.

7 RACING AREA

- 7.1 The Regatta will be sailed on the waters of Sydney Harbour. The start and finish line will be in Athol Bight.

8 THE COURSE

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be around harbour marks and as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

10 PRIZES and TROPHIES

Commemorative engraved 150th Anniversary Riedel glasses and Luigi Bormioli decanters will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd PHS results in each division. Additional prizes and trophies will be awarded for best dressed yacht and overall regatta winner. The Prizegiving will take place at the clubhouse after the regatta.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident.
