Eighty-Fifth Annual Report and Balance Sheet

To be presented to Members at the Annual General Meeting
to be held at History House, 8 Young Street, Circular Quay,
on Thursday, 22nd August, 1957.

The Committee has pleasure in presenting its Report and Balance Sheet for the year ended 31st July, 1957.

RACING

The Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron opened the 1956/57 season with a Regatta on 15th September, when the Club's fleet was invited to race in conjunction with the fleet of the Middle Harbour Yacht Club.

Invitations to take part in racing on other occasions during the season were also extended to the Sydney Amateurs by the Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron, Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club, Royal Prince Edward Yacht Club, Royal Naval Sailing Association, Lake Macquarie Yacht Club, Middle Harbour Yacht Club, and the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia. The Anniversary Regatta and Pittwater Regatta Committee also invited the Club to compete in races. The Committee desires to record its appreciation of the courtesies extended to our racing members by the Clubs and Regattas referred to.

The Club's largest race day of the season, the Annual Flag Day Regatta, was held on 10th November, when fourteen races were started from Kurraba Point comprising all divisions racing with the R.S.Y.S., R.P.A.Y.C., R.P.E.Y.C., the five divisions of the Sydney Amateur fleet, Middle Harbour Yacht Club fleet, and the R.N.S.A. Service Whalers and Island Class Dinghies. An excellent day's racing was enjoyed by both competitors and the spectators. The Sydney Amateur's Flag Day provided racing for all the Sydney Yacht Clubs affiliated with the Yachting Association of N.S.W. under the burgee of the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club. The race officials for the day were Messrs. F. F. Buchanan, and W. S. Chambers, in addition to the Club's regular starter, Mr. W. J. Millard. The Club is very much indebted to these gentlemen for the work they carried out during such a busy afternoon.

Mr. W. J. Millard, the Club's starter, rendered excellent service in this capacity during the past season. The Committee is grateful to Mr. Millard for the considerable amount of time he has spent on this job as well as the job of conveying the race results to the Sunday papers, in the vain hope that they will print them.

A new trophy was added this season, it being the "Bob Brown Perpetual Trophy" awarded to the winner of the Ocean Race to Refuge Bay at Easter and being presented by Mr. Tom Furse and Mr. Grant Crichton.

Mr. H. S. Lloyd, who won the Jubilee Plate II this season has donated another to be known as Jubilee Plate III.

To these generous gentlemen the Club wishes to express its appreciation.

Increased catering costs and the hire of vessels being greater than anticipated. The cost of programmes and postage also showed a considerable increase.
