COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE/ADMINISTRATION

Commodore H. L. Schneider (Chairman), A. F. Grellman, B. Woods, N. G. Cassim, J. A. Middleton, A. W. Merrington, G K. Paton.

This Committee has held five meetings during its term at which thirty-seven recommendations were made to your directors, the main items being — wage increases for staff followed by increases in hourly labour rates — “The Laurels” — fitting out wharf — Y.A. Constitution and payments — Letting of Club flat — Revision of Boatshed charges to include non-member work — Lands Department.

Your Committee has closely watched all financial aspects of the Club, and we have again managed to finance improvements required at our Green Street home without overtaxing resources.

Continuing rises in costs have forced us to increase charges, but examination of the Balance Sheet will show that this was only done where necessary.

The Y.A. of N.S.W. has not yet finalised their constitution, but we have budgeted for the “middle of the road”.

The accounting system has been varied to achieve a stricter control of materials.

BOATSHED

Throughout the past year the Committee has worked actively to increase the business of the boatshed, improve facilities for members and maintain the assets of the Club in good order and condition.

The boatshed business, through the dedicated efforts of Tony Ashleigh, has justified the employment of the additional hand. To increase productivity during the slack periods, approval was granted by the Directors for the contracting of outside work at increased rates. However, patronage by members of the first-rate facilities and service being offered by the Club is the prime objective of the Committee. It is believed that many more members could take advantage of the competent work performed to the benefit of both themselves and the Club.

Many projects envisaged last year have been brought to fruition. Thanks to the untiring efforts of the Development Committee the fitting out wharf has now been completed. This has not only proved a most practical acquisition but has enhanced the whole layout of the Club's premises. The No. 1 slipway has been extended and repaired, and new winch fitted. This gives the Club two all-tide slipping facilities, capable of taking the largest of yachts and cruisers.

Improvements have been made to the boatshed itself to increase efficiency both for the staff and the members. Better lighting, more power points and improved work bench facilities have all been installed throughout the year.

Moorings have shown a high occupancy rate with a good financial return to the Club. The annual maintenance has been completed and all moorings are in good order and condition.

Thanks are due to Tony Ashleigh and Chris Shield for their efficient and competent running of the boatshed, to Mrs. Kartzoff for her secretarial assistance and to the Committee — and, in particular, to Jan Aldous — for their invaluable advice and assistance.

CLUBHOUSE

The 1969 Ball at the Wentworth Hotel was well attended by members and their friends, and it is pleasing to record that guests from other clubs expressed their envy of the spirit which prevails in our club, making for success and enjoyment of this and all our social functions.

The inclusion of members' wives on the Committee has proved very beneficial and their assistance particularly with catering arrangements for various functions during the year has been greatly appreciated. This year ladies and families, other than regular crew members, were invited to join the Idle Hour Day gathering and the general consensus of opinion was that this innovation was most successful, a happy time being had by all.

Other principal social functions enjoyed during the year were — Commodore's Flag Night, a wine-tasting evening, a Christmas barbecue-dance and a night at the Killara 680 Club. These were well attended and thanks to the previously mentioned club spirit, were generally successful.

Northcott Day again came and went smoothly thanks to the concerted efforts of many Club members. It was unfortunate that fewer children than in previous years were able to attend, due to a number contracting colds during the preceding week. However, the Club again provided a bright spot in the year for about 65 crippled children.

A number of guests were encouraged to speak at our monthly meetings on various aspects of the technicalities of sailing. These talks proved most informative and we are grateful to those gentlemen for their valuable time.

With the major improvement of a wharf to be financed during the year, further improvements to the Clubhouse were limited to the much needed improved ladies' facilities, which are a joy to behold and a credit to the Development Committee.

All the Committees contributed to the general running of the Clubhouse and social functions, and their efforts have been appreciated. Special thanks are due to Jack and Rita Maynard for their untiring devotion to feeding us at the barbecue; to Bob Banta for, amongst other things, arranging the installation of a soft drink vending machine in the Boatshed; to Peter Cane for organising the Killara 680 Club night and, of course, to Geoff Cambridge for his many activities, not the least of which is being the collector of revenue.

RACING

In the winter of 1969 a Special Committee was set up between the Royals Clubs and ourselves to examine courses, starting procedures, etc., to see if we could reduce congestion between yachts racing on Sydney Harbour on Saturday afternoons.

This Committee's recommendations resulted in new courses for all our divisions, an extra 2 courses to make 6 for each division — a total of 30 courses we now have! — and new starting times, plus new starting and finishing lines. The results have met general approval, and have beyond doubt removed a lot of hazards from our racing.

The number of entries was again a record with 123 yachts on our programme. The number of Thunderbirds was 21, and for first half of the season all of these were regular starters. We are very proud that in the Thunderbird World Championships, held on Sydney Harbour in January, our yachts came 1st, 2nd and 4th, with "Moonraker" Tony Parkes, as World Champion, "Kaldari" Richard Wilson, runner-up and "Christina" Dick Christian, fourth.

The season was a most unusual one in that we had nothing but light winds, only four races started on No. 2 handicap. We did not do as well as last year in our interclub races; we lost the Daydream Shield back to Middle Harbour Yacht Club, and we came second to Middle Harbour in their Teams Race.

Two Skippers' Meetings were held and were very well attended. No major changes appear likely for next year!

Our sincere thanks go to Mrs. Kartzoff for the programmes being in the post so early every week, to Geoff Cambridge for his boat, and Jack Millard, Don Skinner and their team for such efficient starting and finishing of our races.

DEVELOPMENT

The planning work done by the Committee during previous years has brought results this year.

Tenders were called for the Fitting-out berth which, at the time of writing this report, is well on the way to completion. Repairs to and extension of No. 1 Slipway have been completed most satisfactorily by J. Bailey Pty. Ltd., thus enlarging the scope of the Club's slipping facilities.
