## **COMMODORE'S REPORT**

The year which finished on the 31st May, 1976 was, I believe, successful in a number of areas and as usual the success was not achieved without the more than adequate assistance of a hard working group of members.

The Club's primary objective which of course is the promotion of sailing, was kept well to the forefront. As detailed elsewhere in this report, we enjoyed competition provided by a record racing fleet under the control of the Chairman of the Race Committee, Peter Hamilton, ably assisted on the water by Jack Millard and his starting crew.

The policy adopted by your Board for the season was one of consolidation. As with other organisations, we, from time to time, encounter loose ends. Energies were therefore directed during the year to putting our house in order.

On the Administration scene, a number of projects were undertaken which will provide better information to your Board and enable it to control more firmly the diverse range of activities which are its responsibility.

The Boatshed Committee under the able leadership of Vice Commodore Bob Skinner similarly concentrated on tidying up physical and administrative areas within the Boatshed Department.

Clubhouse activities during the year were highlighted by a number of functions such as the Northcott Crippled Children's Day, the Gaff Riggers' Day, etc. These were ably promoted by Rear Commodore Alastair Merrick and his very enthusiastic Clubhouse Committee.

This Report would seem incomplete without reference to that subject which plagues each and every one of us concerned with the management of Clubs or businesses. I refer of course to finances. It is my pleasure to report that the Club has finished the year on a satisfactory financial footing. In so doing, not only has it met its operating requirements, but it has provided the necessary liquidity to enable your incoming Board to progress with the repair and renovation programme now currently under consideration.

In conclusion, I would like to take this opportunity of thanking sincerely, all those who have made a positive contribution to the Club's progress. I include not only the Honorary Office Bearers and other members who have done so much but also Mrs. Kartzoff, Tony Ashleigh and Carl Speers for the loyalty and support they have provided.

As mentioned elsewhere in the report, the Club finished the year with a satisfactory result.

In line with modern practice, the financial statements have been presented in a more meaningful format. It is anticipated that this, and the accompanying notes, will provide members with a greater appreciation of our financial position.

Because of the state of uncertainty of the economy, a system of funds budgeting and control was introduced at the beginning of the financial year. Your Board receives regular quarterly reports against the funds budget and is therefore in a position to detect problems as they arise and undertake remedial action.

Regular financial reporting is also an important part of the management of the Boatshed and Clubhouse Departments. Each has available regularly monthly reports which indicate levels of operation against predetermined targets.

## BOATSHED

Vice Commodore R. L. Skinner (Chairman); F. D. Bradshaw; D. B. McCormack; B. Ironside; H. L. Schneider; H. H. Jackson; F. Buckley; H. B. North. The Committee's work over the year has primarily been towards renovation and upgrading of boatshed facilities.

The fittings on Nos. 1 and 2 cradles have been renewed and cables on the slipways replaced.

The Electrical Installation in the boatshed has been upgraded.

A system of responsibility for particular operational functions has been adopted. Brian North accepted an interstate appointment and resigned from the Committee early in the year. He was replaced as Moorings Officer by Doug McCormack. Frank Buckley accepted the responsibility of keeping the boatshed in order, particularly in respect of dinghy storage.

The boatshed has continued to trade satisfactorily and at the same time give adequate and economical service to Club Members.

It is regretted that the Club has had to increase charges, but these have been kept to the minimum possible consistent with the maintenance of adequate facilities.

The Boatshed Committee records its thanks to Tony Ashleigh, Nan Kartzoff and Carl Speers all of whom have contributed very considerably towards the smooth operation of this facet of the Club's activities.

## CLUBHOUSE

The year has been an interesting one, thanks to suggestions and ideas from many people associated with the Club. The personal help provided by many individuals called on without notice has also been very much appreciated.

Some events during the year have been notably successful; the Gaffers Day was a most colourful occasion due in no small measure to the period costume which many people wore. Northcott Day was also successful, and the weather was kind for this one day after a period of very unsettled conditions. Mrs. John Jackson was largely responsible for the smooth running of the catering operations on this occasion.

Of the General Meeting programmes, the lecture by Dr. David Lewis stands out particularly, but some excellent films were shown as well on other evenings, including "The Shape of Speed" produced by North Sails.

During the year the Clubhouse has acquired a "pie warmer" for use on Saturday afternoons at the after-race gatherings in the clubhouse, where Mrs. Kartzoff and Mrs. Frater have provided a regular supply of refreshments. This activity has contributed enormously to a pleasant atmosphere for those after-race get-togethers.

A wine-bottling is still to take place and a record number of people have requested to attend the annual dinner dance and prize giving, which suggests that members' interest in the social side of the club is high.

In addition to a note of thanks to all those members of this Club who helped, particular mention must be made of Mrs. Kartzoff and Tony Ashleigh whose assistance in the running of the clubhouse affairs has been invaluable.

Further, Bill's wealth of knowledge and experience in matters nautical make his advice invaluable — no wonder his telephone is forced to work overtime.

Thanks are due also to the other members of the Committee. The Club is fortunate in having such enthusiastic people prepared to devote time to the organisation of our racing.

Mrs. Kartzoff's efficiency with the pointscores and handicap adjustments is evident in the punctual publication of the weekly programmes. This expertise, combined with so pleasant a disposition, renders her assistance valuable indeed — many many thanks are appropriate.

## **SYDNEY AMATEUR SAILING CLUB DIRECTORS' REPORT**

In accordance with a resolution of the board of directors, the directors report as follows with respect to the club's profit for the financial year ended 31st May, 1976 and the state of the club's affairs at that date.

1. The operating profit of the club for the year ended 31st May, 1976 was \$7,608.
2. The results of the club's operations during the financial year were not, in the opinion of the directors, substantially affected by any item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature.
3. The directors recommend that no dividend be declared.
4. The directors took reasonable steps before the statements of income and expenditure and balance sheet were made out to ascertain that all known bad debts were written off and that adequate provision was made for doubtful debts.
5. At the date of this report the directors are not aware of any circumstances which would render the amount written off for bad debts or the amount of the provision for doubtful debts inadequate to a substantial extent.
6. At the date of this report the directors are not aware of any circumstances which would render the values attributed to current assets in the accounts misleading.
7. No charge on the assets of the club has arisen since the end of the financial year to the date of this report to secure the liabilities of any other person. No contingent liability has arisen since the end of the financial year to the date of this report.
8. No contingent or other liability has become enforceable or is likely to become enforceable within the period of twelve months after the end of the financial year which, in the opinion of the directors, will or may affect the ability of the club to meet its obligations when they fall due.
9. In the interval between the end of the financial year and the date of this report no item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature has arisen which is likely, in the opinion of the directors, to affect substantially the results of the club's operations for the next succeeding financial year.
10. Since the end of the previous financial year no director of the club has received or become entitled to receive a benefit (other than a benefit included in the aggregate amount of emoluments received or due and receivable by directors shown in the accounts, or the fixed salary of a full time employee of the club) by reason of a contract made by the club or a related corporation, with the director or with a firm of which he is a member, or with a company in which he has a substantial financial interest.
