COMMODORE'S REPORT

Another year in our history has concluded with the S.A.S.C. continuing with the objective of supporting and promoting yachting.

Members were fortunate in having Officers, a Board of Directors and Staff dedicated to the main purpose of our club and to see that the members' interests were considered at all times.

To ensure the standard of the club has been maintained, property and equipment kept in first class order and to be able to pay our way, has not been easy in view of the rising costs over the last year. However, whilst a tight financial control has been maintained, your Officers and Board of Directors have always aimed at and achieved a high standard.

The S.A.S.C. has organised many events during its 110 years of operation, but I am sure the 1981 S.A.S.C. Gaffers Day must rate as one of the most spectacular events seen on Sydney Harbour. The coverage by the media was very generous and recorded for history that the S.A.S.C., after all these years, is still a strong and vigorous club.

The annual Northcott Day for Crippled Children was conducted very smoothly, well supported by members, club yachts and skippers. Approximately 95 children and 100 adults were entertained.

All social functions have been well attended. The 1981 dinner & prize giving night, wine and cheese tasting night to celebrate the opening of the season and the Christmas function were all booked out.

This year has also seen the long association between the Y.A. of N.S.W. and the S.A.S.C. continued with our immediate past Commodore, Colin Crisp elected to the position of president of the Y.A. of N.S.W.

In accordance with the Articles of Association, I must conclude my term as Commodore after three years and in doing so, I would like to say that it has been a pleasure for me to work to achieve the various objectives, and I am particularly grateful to the members for electing me to this important office in the club. Be assured that I will give to the Commodore Elect my full support and co-operation. I am deeply appreciative of the help afforded me by the Flag Officers, the Directors, the members and my wife Beryl and I assure them that their support, suggestions and advice have contributed to the success of S.A.S.C.

In addition, my thanks also to the various Committee members, the Starters, to our Assistant Secretary, Mrs Diana Fitzgerald, Mrs Pat Ferris, Mrs Jeanette Percival, Carl Speers, Tony Ashleigh and Peter Wargent.

On the racing scene, another successful season has been completed. The association between S.A.S.C. and R.S.Y.S. to provide good competitive racing has successfully continued with our No. 1 Division and the R.S.Y.S. No. 2 Division racing for the first time under the title of the combined division with R.S.Y.S., and S.A.S.C. and R.S.Y.S. ½ ton division yachts racing with the S.A.S.C.

As well as the various divisions in which yachts are regularly raced, an offshore division was commenced this year and appears to be growing into another strong division.

The S.A.S.C. were successful in retaining the Day Dream Shield, an annual event between the M.H.Y.C. and S.A.S.C.

As indicated by the table, there has been a net reduction of six in total membership. This occurred despite increases in numbers of new members joining in all categories. The offset resulted from resignations which this year were twelve higher than the preceding period.

On the financial side, your Committee is pleased to report that results have once again been in line with the financial plan adopted by your Board at the beginning of the year.

When formulating the financial plan for next year, the opportunity was taken to review the basis of all charges. As a result, the Committee recommended and the Board approved a change in the method of calculating slipping charges. These will now be charged on the basis of length and will allow better comparison with charges levied by other organisations.

Regrettably, it has been once again necessary to increase charges for the range of services provided to members. These however, have been contained within the limits of the Consumer Price Index and it is pleasing to note that they remain more than competitive with other comparable facilities.

No major projects were undertaken on Boatshed equipment during 1981/82. An order has been placed for repair work to be undertaken on the rails of No. 2 Slipway below low water.

The demand for Club Moorings continues to be high, and at one stage during the year the waiting list was closed for a period. It is hoped that extra moorings may become available if the Club's application to the MSB to establish concentrated moorings in the northern part of Mosman Bay is successful.

Both boats have seen much use during the year. "Nancy K" has been fitted with a new rubber fender, which, whilst expensive, should last for many years and help protect members' topside paintwork. At the end of the summer season "Captain Amora" was taken out of service for a major overhaul of the injector fuel pump and other engine maintenance.

2. The principal activity of the club during the year was to promote the sport of amateur sailing.
3. The club incurred a loss of \$2,216 during the year ended 31st May, 1982. No provision for income tax is necessary.
4. The results of the operations of the club during the financial year were not, in the opinion of the directors, substantially affected by any item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature.
5. No issue of shares or debentures was made by the club during the financial year.
6. The directors took reasonable steps before the profit and loss account and balance sheet were made out to ascertain that there were no bad debts and that adequate provision was made for doubtful debts.
7. At the date of this report the directors are not aware of any circumstances which would render their decisions not to write off any debts or the amount of the provision for doubtful debts inadequate to any substantial extent.
8. At the date of this report the directors are not aware of any circumstances which would render the values attributed to current assets in the accounts misleading.
9. No charge on the assets of the club has arisen since the end of the financial year to the date of this report to secure the liabilities of any other person.
10. No contingent liability has arisen since the end of the financial year to the date of this report.
11. No contingent or other liability has become enforceable or is likely to become enforceable within the period of twelve months after the end of the financial year which, in the opinion of the directors, will or may affect the ability of the club to meet its obligations when they fall due.
