SASC Sailing Program 2024-2025 – Sail GP 8th February 2025 – Updated Instructions

Sail GP will be conducted on Sydney Harbour on Saturday 8th February.
There is an exclusion zone starting at 3pm for Sydney Harbour (see map below).
Sail GP races commence at 4pm.

This will affect SASC Saturday Racing.

Hence there are a number of changes to the Sailing Instructions for 8th February:

- Starting times will be **1 hour earlier**.
- **Warning times** are therefore as follows:
 - Super 30 Warning at 11.40am
 - Cavalier 28 Warning at 11.45am
 - Cruiser Racer Warning at 11.50am
 - Classic Overall – Warning at 11.55am
- First Numeral Board (999) will be displayed at 11.59am
- Time limit will be 2.45pm (if you are unable to finish by 2.45pm, then please advise the start boat and clear the exclusion zone).
- Courses will be as per the program, however, may be shortened or chosen to avoid Rose Bay.
