- The Name of the Event in 1988:** The S.A.S.C. Channel 7 Bi-Centennial National Gaffers Regatta.
- Participants:** A rally for vessels that hoist a spar.
- Present:** Our Patron, His Excellency Air Marshal Sir James Rowland A.C. K.B.E. D.F.C. A.F.C. Governor of New South Wales and Lady Rowland will honour us with their presence on this occasion.

His Excellency and Lady Rowland will arrive at the Club at 10.40AM and continue to follow the Regatta from the S.A.S.C. official vessel during the afternoon.

### PROGRAM

There will be -

1. An Assembly of vessels taking part in the Regatta on the Western shore of Mosmans Bay (at the S.A.S.C. and nearby).

A number of yachts will be on display at the Club wharf from 10.00 AM.

2. There will also be a parade of selected vessels. The parade will proceed from Cockatoo Island or East of Clarkes Point down the Harbour passing close to Garden Island and finishing in Mosmans Bay, just inside Robertsons Point.

The parade will commence at approximately 9.30AM arriving at Mosmans Bay at approximately 11.00AM.

### NEW ZEALAND BI-CENTENNIAL GIFT

As Members are probably aware, the New Zealand Bi-Centennial Gift to Australia is the Gaff rigged cutter "AKARANA" which will be in the parade and on display at the S.A.S.C.
