**Dear BPYC members, guests and SASC skippers,**

Please find the attached Notice of Race for the 2026 Don Deller to be held on February 14th, 2026.

As usual a group dinner will be held that night at RMYC for crews and any guests who wish to join.

Key requirements for this email:

### **1) Entry details for RMYC Berth Booking**

- a) Vessel Name
- b) Contact details - email and mobile
- c) Vessel owner
- d) Insurance provider
- e) Policy number
- f) Policy expiry date
- g) LOA, Beam, draft

This information is required by RMYC in order to book berths, if you miss this email deadline there is no guarantee of a berth on race day. Each skipper shall pay for his own berth with the RMYC on arrival.

### **2) Pay the Entry Fee:**

**3) If you're a SASC boat please confirm via email that you have completed your 2024-2025 CAT 5 or above certificate/audit form. No need to send a copy as we will concur with the SASC team.**

Please find below details for the Start and finish.

### **START**


Start time is **1030am** for a fleet start, with a standard SASC Boat based Fleet Start of 5 minutes. Start Boat will be in the vicinity of Watsons Bay.

### **HANDICAPS**

The BPYC Sailsys handicapping policy is that we take the latest (most recent) Sailsys handicap on record and apply this to the BPYC race.

### **FINISH**

The finishing line is in the vicinity of Palm Beach Ferry Wharf: a transit between Red Lateral beacon 002 (a red post with a can top mark) and red lateral mark 003 (immediately east of 002), passing 002 to Port. See figure below.



**Boats must record their own finish time** as they cross the transit between Red Lateral beacon 002 and red lateral mark 003. **Please SMS your finish time to 0416 093 215.**

## **DINNER**
