NOTICE OF RACE

A cordial invitation is extended to owners of all classic yachts to enter Gaffers Day to be held on Sunday 16 October 2022 on the waters of Sydney Harbour. The Sydney Amateur Sailing Club is celebrating 150 years of sailing on Sydney Harbour in 2022.

Courses

Courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions issued by the SASC and published on the website.

Divisions

Divisions will include Gaff Rigged Yachts, Bermudian Yachts, Metre Boats, Cousta Boats, Ranger Class yachts and Historical 18ft Skiffs.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third handicap places in each division. Special event prizes including best dressed boat and crew, together with Perpetual Trophies will be awarded at the Clubhouse after the rally.

Rules

- a) The rally will be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the AS Prescriptions and Safety Regulations (as amended below), and the Sailing Instructions as they apply to this event.
- b) Safety Requirements:
 - Each yacht must hold a valid Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form, minimum standard Category 7.
 - Insurance: Yachts shall have adequate current third-party property liability insurance cover and third-party personal liability insurance cover of not less than \$10,000,000 (ten million) for each incident. Evidence of insurance will be provided to the Organising Authority upon request.
