REQUEST FOR REDRESS

Protestor: Martin Van Der Wal– *Hoana*

Event: SASC Classics Division Race 7 –Saturday 2nd November

Request for redress is Valid

Facts found:

Hoana, *Lolita* and nine other yachts were racing in the SASC Classics Division Race 7. The wind was from the NNE, gusting to 30 knots.

Near Shark Island mark *Lolita* lost a man overboard.

Hoana immediately stopped racing to stand by in case any help was needed. Once a life ring was thrown to the man overboard and the rescue was in process, *Hoana* restarted racing.

Hoana lost two minutes whilst standing by.

Applicable rules:

RRS Rule 1.1, 60.1 (b), 62.1 (c), Case 20.

Decision:

Hoana is to be scored points for 4th for Race 7. No other yacht's scores are to be changed.

Hoana's handicap for Race 8 shall remain the same as for Race 7.
