Starting Line – Between the Brigantine “Tara-Ipo” and a Red and Yellow Flagmark, North of Clarke Island

Course A – Start – Chowder Bay – Shark Island – Chowder Bay
Shark Island – Finish

Course B – Start – Neutral Bay Mark – Neilson Park Gas Buoy
Naval Buoy No. 2 – Shark Island – Finish

Finishing Line – Between the Brigantine “Tara-Ipo” and a Red and Yellow Flagmark, North of Clarke Island.

Yachts will race in two divisions, as listed hereafter.

Spinnakers may not be set as the majority of competitors do not possess one.
