INVITATION AND NOTICE TO ENTRANTS

Firstly, on behalf of SASC I would like to personally invite you to enter our Metre and Metre-type Rally on Sunday 18th February.

There will be a scratch start, rather than time of start, for a few reasons, but the starting line will be long enough to make sure there will be no issues. As you will see in the Sailing Instructions depending on the wind direction there are two possible starting lines, however the finish line will be in Athol Bay regardless of the course sailed.

I hope whatever the wind direction that there will be a mix of upwind and downwind legs, but unless Bill Gale has some control over the wind gods (he has been asked) we will have to deal with what we get. The RC may shorten the course at any mark if the breeze dies out. This is a no-extras rally, but genoas and jibs may be poled out.

After the race I invite all yachts to come back to the SASC. There are a few spots alongside the pontoon, plus extra spots within the mooring piles. There may also be some moorings available, as well as some rafting-up if weather is suitable.
